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Purpose of discussion

Experiences implementing supply chain improvements

- What 2-3 factors were/will be required to scale this change?

Role of political will

- Were there certain individuals that served as <u>champions</u> or advocates? What role did they play? What did they do to influence decision-makers?
- What collaborations or <u>partnerships</u> were invaluable? How did these work?
- Was there a <u>key moment</u> or event that helped galvanize attention to the issue?
- What <u>evidence</u> did you use to bring attention to the issue?
- What could you have done <u>differently</u> to achieve better or faster results?

Strategies for generating political will

- How do you <u>cultivate</u> leadership from higher-level officials?
 From partners?
- What <u>key moments</u> can be used to galvanize attention to and interest in a supply chain effort?
- How do you make supply chain issues a <u>priority</u> to people who are juggling multiple priorities?

Some advocacy best practices

- Have a crystal <u>clear vision</u> of the change you'd like to see
- Find out who has the <u>power</u> to make the change happen and learn what interests that person
- Look for <u>key moments</u> to make your case for action using compelling <u>local data</u> and evidence (even photos and testimonials can be powerful)
- Show how your issue relates to that person's <u>priorities</u> (e.g., MDG goals, GVAP targets, system efficiency, maternal-child health, etc.)
- Be explicit about the <u>action</u> you'd like the decision-maker to take
