

Registering on the VPPN:

A reminder, for those VPPN members who were registered on the previous VPPN website:


- Your previous VPPN membership has been moved over and your account is now active.
- However, if you have not already done so, you need to on login at TechNet-21.org using your email address and creating a new password to gain access to the platform.

For those VPPN members who are new and/or have never been registered on any VPPN website:

- After cross-referencing, I have found a number of contacts who receive email announcements but have not registered on any VPPN site.

Managing Alerts:

As mentioned in the Launch Session on 30 January, the best way to stay connected is via your email notifications. Everyone is set to a default list of notifications; however, you can also modify what types and how many notifications come through to your email by going to “Settings/Manage Alerts/”.
