



ACCOMPLISHING OUR MISSION

Boost is a virtual community that connects immunization professionals to peers, support and resources to learn and grow and equips professionals to lead in challenging situations.



Connect

Boost is an on and offline community where immunization professionals can connect with peers and stakeholders and expand their professional network.



Learn

Boost provides access to experts and resources to help immunization professionals build leadership and management capacity and advance their careers.



Lead

Boost is designed to help immunization professionals lead immunization programs in challenging contexts.

BOOST DELIVERS GLOBAL REACH WITH LOCAL IMPACT

Boost acts as a bridge, sharing information between immunization professionals at all levels of the system and global actors.

Immunization professionals share stories and experiences to address needs from the field Boost surfaces emerging needs, threats, opportunities and challenges through regular pulse surveys, moderated discussions and the Bright Spots initiative.

Learning Groups

Webinars & Access to Experts

Facilitated webinars on both technical and adaptive topics using Zoom; recorded sessions, supporting resources and discussions hosted in corresponding learning group on the Boost platform. Members also are able to access Boost community experts including immunization professionals and implementing partners in a safe space.



Curated Resources

Carefully curated resources from partners and Boost community members including tools, job aids and videos on known and emerging topics; can be curated based on specific needs of learning groups or specific audiences within the Boost community.

FOUNDATIONAL CAPACITY BUILDING

Recognizing the quantity of high-quality technical training, Boost's core content offerings focus on foundational capacity building including adaptive leadership, advocacy and problem solving. As a result of COVID-19, Boost has also been working with partners to respond to a need for up-to-date technical content.

Adaptive Leadership

Adaptive leadership is the practice of mobilizing people to tackle tough challenges and thrive and is comprised of a set of tools and techniques for moving organizations, communities and teams beyond the status quo.

Community Organizing

Community organizing focuses on developing and building cooperative power of the community itself to both address the challenges and advocate directly without intermediary organizations or professionals.
