COVAX: Monitoring options offered by UNICEF

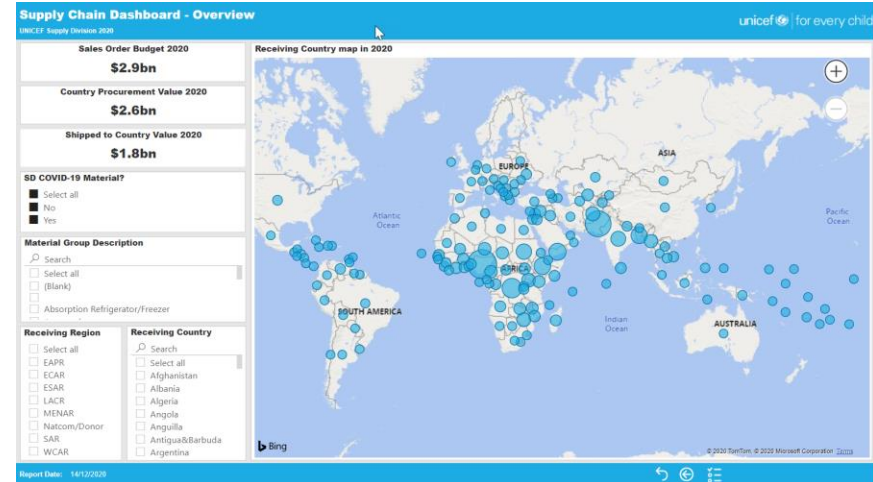
- As part of the Procurement Agent role, UNICEF COs will have the Dashboard available to be on top of the status of the transactions by COVAX
- As part of the Procurement Agent role, UNICEF SD will provide COs with a Provisional Plan after each round of allocation.
- VIVA will include COVAX vaccines and can support the planning process of COVAX
- An external dashboard is expected to be available displaying allocated vaccine quantities and status of the vaccine in the supply chain, i.e. procured, delivered

For COs: Supply Chain Dashboard in InSight

The UNICEF Supply Chain Dashboard is a tool for monitoring, information and analysis

- Has Supply and Logistics data sourced from UNICEF's ERP (VISION) system
- Provides high-level information, as well as order-specific features with an option to drill-down into detail
- Contains summary data to empower decision-making
- Contains a report to highlight exceptions

More views to be launched early 2021 to support detailed monitoring of the COVAX supply chain

Provisional Plans will be shared after each allocation round to UNICEF COs. The plans will contain critical information for you to plan your own logistics:

- ✓ Allocated quantity
- ✓ Unit price
- ✓ Cold chain requirements
- ✓ Weight and Volume
- ✓ Supplier information

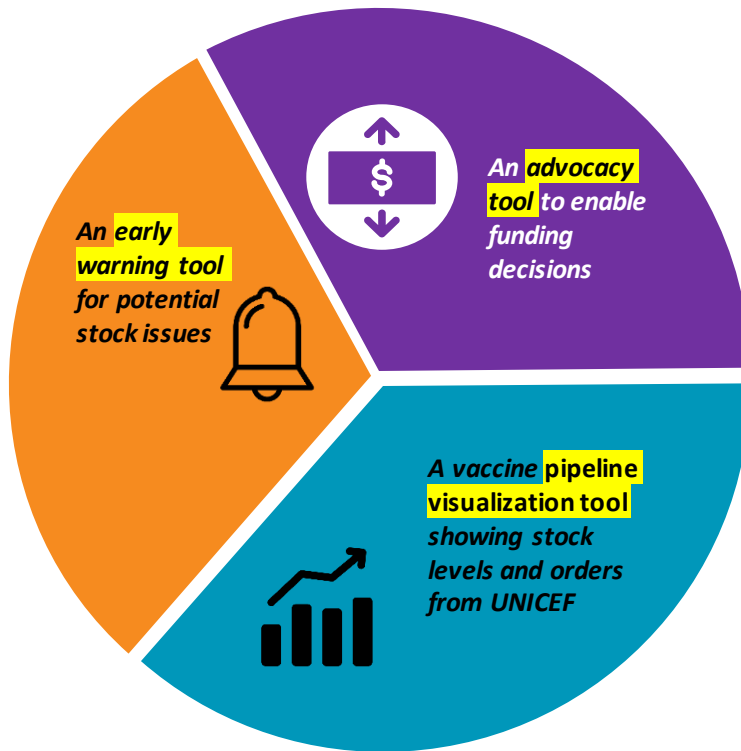

ViVa is a free and easy-to-use **online tool** for country governments





39 countries
using ViVa

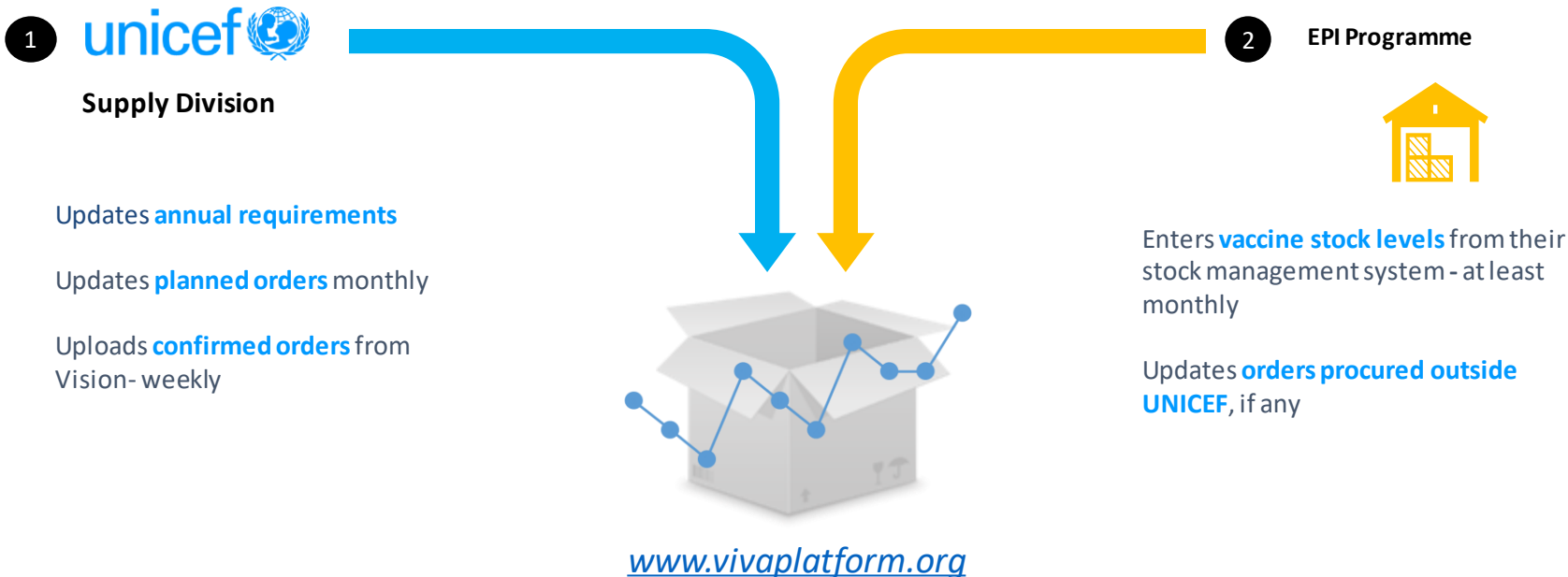
519 users

- 95% of users find ViVa very useful
- 72% reported that ViVa helped them address threats to stock-outs
- 63% used ViVa to address a threat of overstock

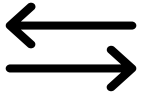

For government partners: Next Generation Stock Management Tool

Available
Q3 2021



- Ensures vaccine stock managers and other EPI staff are supported to manage the vaccine program



- Builds off nearly 15 years of user experience and institutionalization (~ 40 countries)



- No or minimal implementation and support costs expected for countries



- Once developed, the new platform can be quickly available to countries



- **Will provide stock visibility up to the district level including for COVID-19 vaccines**

Country view

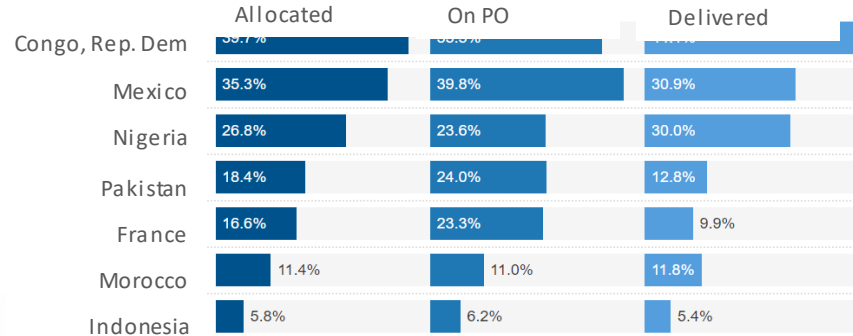
- Filter based, for all countries
