Madagascar*: Joined the Facility later and did not have an allocation but received 250k redeployed doses from Congo (DRC)

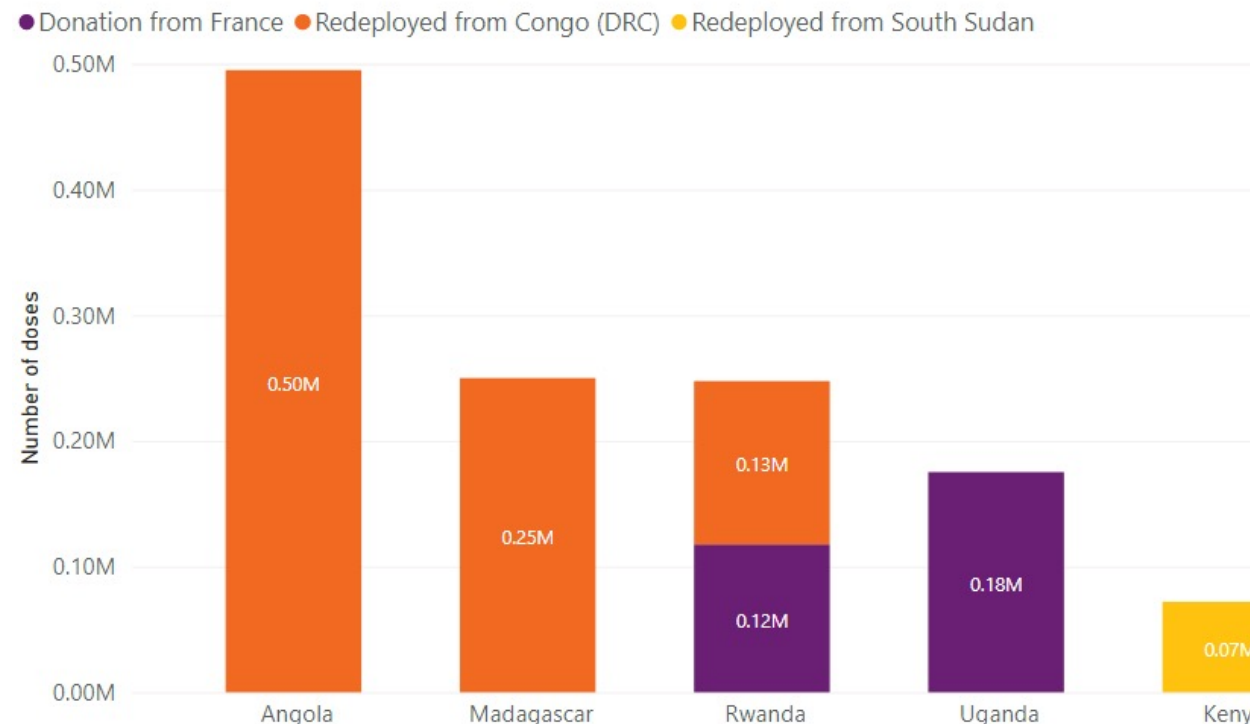
South Africa: first shipment of 1.39 million doses is planned on 27th June
