Which components are given more weight under CDS funding? On what factors does budget ceiling depend?

The CDS was put together to avail resources to countries in order to support the delivery of vaccines, as the initial experience suggests that countries have challenges with delivery. That may have influenced the weight given to categories, but Gavi will be able to provide more information on the weights. We have a CDS session on October 6 which will talk about the needs-based application components including a Q&A and updated guidance document. There is additional stream of work that will enable determination of post operational determination of cost per person vaccinated. This is through the expenditure tracking frameworking using NHA (SHA) Already 4 countries are part of the expenditure tracking work.

We heard from GAVI last week that countries will be required to submit a detailed mapping of all the available financing from internal and external sources to support COVID-19 vaccines rollout, in order to access the needs-based Country Delivery Support funds later this year. Will AFRO be supporting countries directly (or developing tools) for this new mapping activity?

In-country mapping of resources available will be done by government and partners working together. AFRO will deploy support as needed to fill gaps where there are challenges in capacity, to do the mapping. The guidelines/template for needs-based CDS will provide better information.
